This product would be distributed on the streets to help rescue minors who were trafficked and needed rescue.

In 2018, Colbert eventually sold the formula to Shades of Monet cosmetics transitioning 'Shades of Monet' into an educational platform. Which is slated to relaunch in 2021. This platform was designed to help entrepreneurs follow their passion while taking their ideas from concept to launch.

With over 20 years of sales experience across the globe and after creating several startups of her own, Colbert chronicles her humble beginnings throughout her book 'Shear Destiny' as a self-taught businesswoman who uses her story to help empower other survivors and entrepreneurs. Her former role with companies such as REDKEN (a L'Oréal brand), LexisNexis (Risk Debt Solutions company), and The March Group (Mergers & Acquisitions firm) was to increase market share.
