Faythe Kadona is a Survivor Leader | Office Manager with Street Grace, she has a bachelor's in business and is currently working on her Master's in Criminal Justice and Administration. As someone with lived experience in the field of human trafficking, addiction, and domestic violence who keeps God at the center of life she is also the chair of the Street Grace Survivor Advisory Board and certified in Trauma Informed care for adult and youth.

Faythe is a certified facilitator with Ending the Game, is the first woman in Georgia to be a licensed contract facilitator for TYRO and currently teaches women the TYRO Mom's leadership program and how to overcome incarceration to integrate back into their family units.

Faythe has helped draft key legislation, along with the Survivor Advisory Board to assist survivors in getting their records restricted which passed under SB435 in 2019. She also serves with Atlanta Redemption Ink on appointments with survivors of self-harm and branding cover-ups and was recently inducted into the National Society of Leadership and Success.
